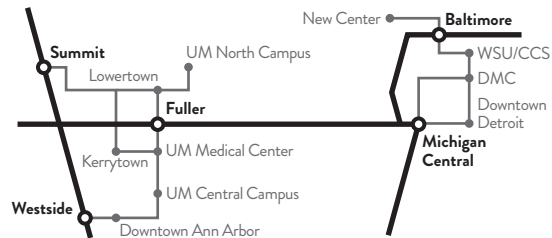

The distance of your trip determines your rail fare. It's easy – look at the route map and find your origin and destination stations. Count all the fare zones involved with your trip – including the zone where you start, the zones you travel through and the zone where you end.

Fare Vending Machines are located at every station. They sell tickets and passes of all types. Be sure to have a valid fare before boarding. Once on the train, please have your ticket or pass ready for verification.

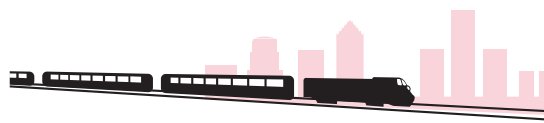

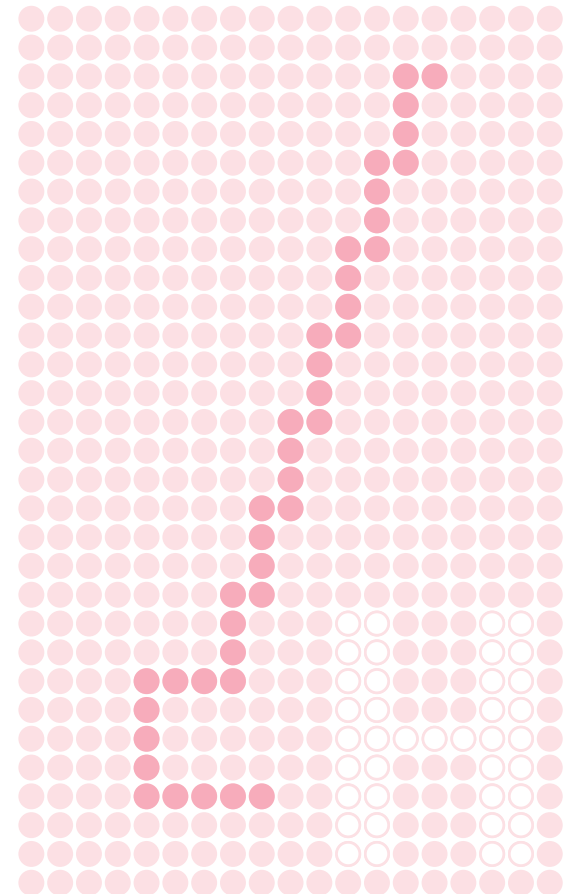
The whole system is Wheelchair Accessible. We offer Bike Racks on all trains and at all stations. Commuter Parking is available at 43 stations.

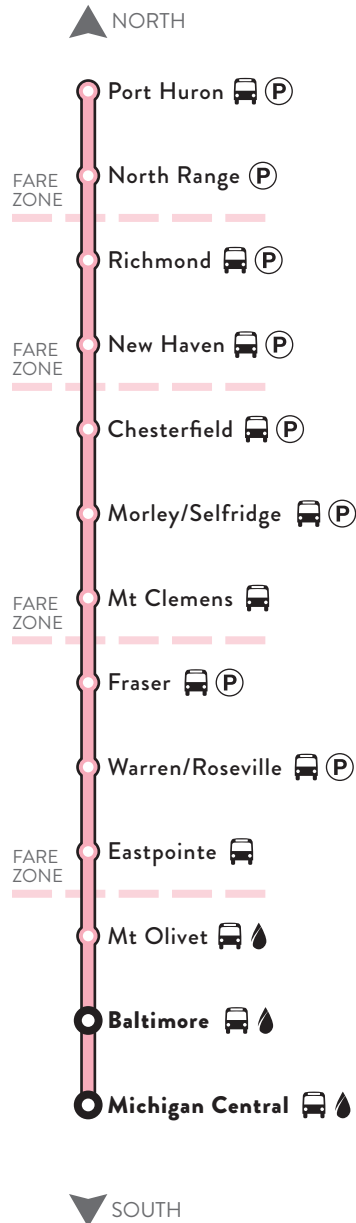


Regional Rail Schedule
