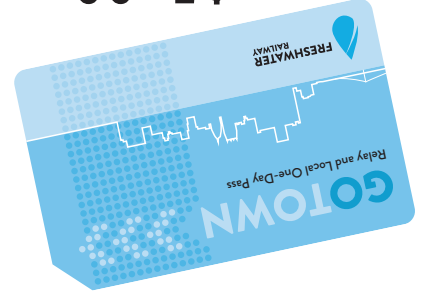


Ride All Day!



If you're out exploring for the day, you can't go wrong with the **GOTOWN Day Pass**. It's available on all buses and at selected local merchants for five bucks. Use it for unlimited rides on all Relay and Local buses in Detroit – it is valid from your first swipe until 3:00am the next day. The city is yours!

## GO TO TOWN!

Reduced fares are available for Seniors and Persons with Disabilities. Discounted fares may also apply for certain special events. See [www.fwrail.org](http://www.fwrail.org) for details.

It's super-easy. If you have a rail fare (One-Way, 10 Ride, 31 Day), just swipe it as you board the bus. Don't have a rail fare with you? Pay right there on the bus – exact fare in bills or coins, please! If you're riding the bus to connect with a train, ask for a coupon – it's valid for a \$2.00 discount on any rail fare. 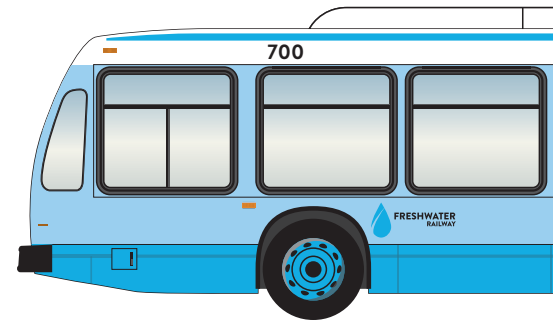
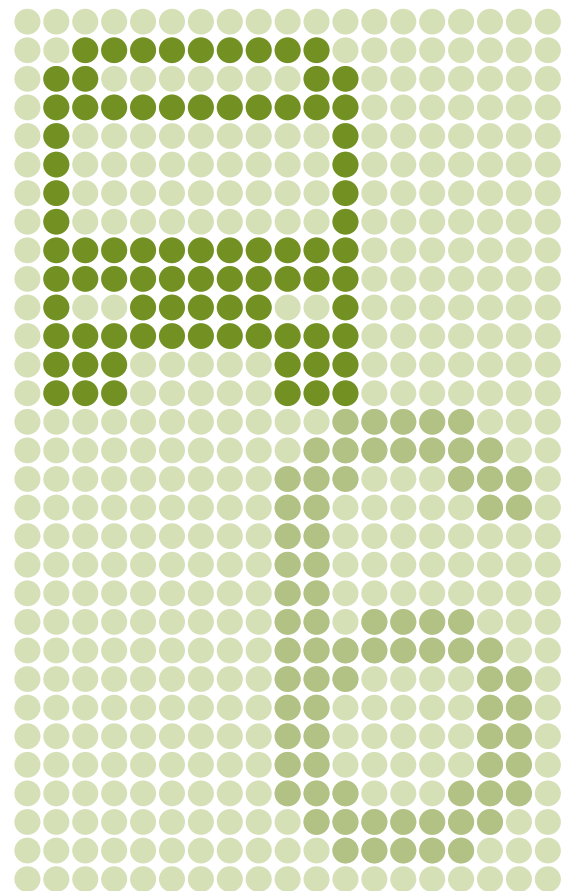

Learn the basics and you'll know the universal language of transit schedules...

## 1 Today is ...

Transit services follow different schedules on different days.

Locate the schedule that applies to your trip:

## 2 I'm leaving from...

Once you determine the direction you're heading, read the **timepoints** across the top.

They are major points along the route that "anchor" the schedule.

Buses make other stops, too – use the nearest timepoint to estimate when your bus is due.

## 3 I'm ready to go at...

Found your timepoint? Great.

Now, read down – you're looking at a full list of times when a bus will pass that timepoint.

Pick your departure time and read across. The bus will arrive at timepoints down the line at the times shown.
